

Tic-Tac-Toe Reading 9-weeks Assignment (Due the last Monday of the 9 weeks)

Ask your best friend - "What is the best book you have ever read?" Write the name, author, and have them sign it.	Read an article about outer space. Include the article when turning in the assignment.	Draw a picture to illustrate a character in a story you have read. List the name of the story and character.	Ask an adult to read a poem out loud to you. Write down the name of the poem and have them sign it.	Read one book this 9-weeks. Explain the plot to your relative (mom, dad, gma, gpa, etc.). Have them sign to verify you have read the book.
Use a Venn Diagram to compare and contrast two characters you have read about. Write the book(s) the characters are from.	Ask an 8th grade teacher the title of the favorite book. Write down the title and have them sign your paper.	Read an article about baseball. Include the article when turning in the assignment.	Read one book this 9-weeks. Explain the plot to your relative (mom, dad, gma, gpa, etc.). Have them sign to verify you have read the book.	Research new books. List one book that was written in the last two years, that you want to read. List the book name and author.
Read a Valentines Day or St. Patrick's Day themed poem. What is the name of the poem and who is the author?	Listen and pay attention to a book Mr. Decker is reading in class. Have him sign this sheet.	Read one book this 9-weeks. Explain the plot to your relative (mom, dad, gma, gpa, etc.). Have them sign to verify you have read the book.	Ask a 7th grade teacher the title of the favorite book. Write down the title and have them sign your paper.	Read an article about the ocean. Include the article when turning in the assignment.
Read an article about an art topic. Include the article when turning in the assignment.	Read one book this 9-weeks. Explain the plot to your relative (mom, dad, gma, gpa, etc.). Have them sign to verify you have read the book.	Ask a relative to think back to a book they read when they were younger. Why can they still remember it today? Name of book and why?	Listen and pay attention to a book Mr. Decker is reading in class. Have him sign this sheet.	Read a poem written by Shel Silverstein. Include the title of the poem and if you liked it or not.
Read a book this 9-weeks. Explain the plot to your relative (mom, dad, gma, gpa, etc.). Have them sign to verify you have read the book.	What is the first sentence in the classic book The Adventures of Tom Sawyer , written by Mark Twain? Write it down.	Listen and pay attention to a book Mr. Decker is reading in class. Have him sign this sheet.	Read an article you find funny. Include the article when turning in the assignment.	Which setting in a book was your favorite? Write down the name of the book and where the setting of the story takes place.

Directions:

You must choose 5 activities on the Tic-Tac-Toe board. They must be in a row horizontally, vertically, or diagonally. You may only use an article once.

Example: If you read a math article, it cannot count as the math article and article of any length selection

You may turn it in at any time during the 9-weeks. The final due date is last Monday of the 9-weeks period.

Turn in this sheet (mark the items completed) with any documents required by the activity selected.

This is worth 50 points toward your final 9-weeks grade.
